1 ENOCH 5:7-9

⁷ And all the righteous will rejoice, and there will be forgiveness of sins, and every kind of mercy and peace and tolerance: There will be salvation for them, a splendid light. And for you sinners, there will be no salvation, but a curse will remain on you all.

⁸ And for you, the godless, there will be a curse. ⁹ But for the chosen, there will be light, joy, and peace, and they shall inherit the earth.

1 ENOCH 60:6

⁶ long-suffering towards those who dwell on the earth. And when the day, and the power, and the punishment, and the judgement come, which Yahuah of Hosts hath prepared for those who worship not the righteous law, and for those who deny the righteous judgement, and for those who take His name in vain—that day is prepared, for the elect a covenant, but for sinners an inquisition.

- The final covenant means no more sin — eternal peace.
